# INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW AND THE CENTRAL NEBRASKA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

This Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (the "Agreement") between the City of Broken Bow, Nebraska ("City") and the Central Nebraska Economic Development District ("CNEDD") has been entered into to permit the City, jointly and cooperatively, to make efficient use of its powers by enabling them to participate in the CNEDD.

#### **THE PARTIES AGREE** as follows:

- 1. <u>Parties.</u> The parties to this Agreement are as follows:
  - A. Central Nebraska Economic Development District (CNEDD), an economic development district formed pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act in Nebraska planning and development region 3 under the provisions of Sections 13-1901 and 13-1902, Reissue Revised Statues of Nebraska, 1943, as amended. The principal office of the CNEDD is located at 106 East State Street P.O. Box 825, Atkinson, Nebraska, 68713.
  - B. All government entities which are organized and existing under the laws of the State of Nebraska; and are eligible and wish to participate, and have adopted the attached resolution. These entities are members in good standing of CNEDD.
- 2. Purpose. This agreement has been entered into by the parties for the purpose of providing a means by which the member governmental entities, herein referred together as participants, may jointly and cooperatively use, exercise and implement, through the auspices of the CNEDD, any of their powers, privileges or authority on a basis of mutual advantage to efficiently provide services and facilities in a manner and pursuant to forms of governmental organization that will best accord with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities and creating and implementing community and economic development programs and cooperatively exercising all of the powers, privileges and authority as authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act as set forth in Sections 23-2201 to 23-2207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, as amended (the "Interlocal Act").

The CNEDD and the Participants may have and exercise all powers, privileges or authority and make use of all benefits jointly and cooperatively to which each of the parties separately is entitled under State and federal law; provided, however, that nothing herein shall prevent any of the parties hereto from separately applying for any such benefits to which they may be entitled.

- 3. Organization. The Participants agree to conduct their activities hereunder in the manner provided for herein, in the Interlocal Act, in the Bylaws of the CNEDD attached hereto as Attachment 1 (the "BYLAWS"), the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference. The Participants hereby delegate to the CNEDD and authorize the CNEDD to exercise and employ such of the Participants' powers, privileges or authority as the Participants may jointly and cooperatively use, exercise and implement for and on its own behalf on a basis of mutual advantage in order to facilitate, create and implement community and economic development programs for the benefit of the Participants.
- **4. <u>Duration.</u>** This agreement shall become effective upon execution by the parties hereto and shall continue in effect indefinitely until termination as provided herein.
- 5. <u>Powers.</u> This CNEDD shall have all powers, privileges and authority necessary and incidental to manage the affairs of the CNEDD and to carry out the intent and purpose of this Agreement which are not inconsistent with law, the AGREEMENT, the Interlocal Act, or the Bylaws of the CNEDD.
- **6. <u>Financing.</u>** The CNEDD shall not be operated for private profit but shall be operated in such manner as shall tend to enhance the economic welfare of the Participants.
- 7. <u>Termination.</u> This agreement may be terminated by the joint or several actions of the parties hereto; and the CNEDD may be dissolved or liquated, and its property and assets acquired, as a result of this agreement may be disposed of in accordance with the terms of this agreement.
- **8.** <u>Amendments.</u> This Agreement may be amended by a written instrument approved by the CNEDD Council of Officials at the time of amendment.

#### **RESOLUTION 2018-4**

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-5**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY BROKEN BOW, NEBRASKA:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby find and determine that Resolution No. 2017-78, which Resolution made certain findings and levied special assessments in Street Improvement Districts 2014-1 and 2014-2, was adopted, on November 28, 2017; that upon further review, certain errors were found in the schedule of assessments approved and made a part of Resolution 2017-78 and that such errors should be corrected;

NOW THEREFORE, Resolution No. 2017-78 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Council find and determine: That the Council has heretofore designated this time and place for considering and levying special assessments upon property specially benefited by paving improvements in Street Improvement Districts Nos. 2014-1 and 2014-2 to pay the cost of constructing same; that notice of the time and place of holding this meeting for said purpose has been duly given as provided by statute by publication in the Custer County Chief, a legal newspaper published in the City, for more than four weeks (five consecutive weekly publications) before the time designated therein for holding this meeting said publication being made in the issues of said paper published on October 26, November 2, November 9, November 16, and November 22, 2017; that the Mayor and Council have at this session heard all persons who desired to be heard in reference to the special benefits or damages thereto by reason of the construction of said improvements and with reference thereto have considered the advice of the engineer in charge of the construction of said improvements.
- 2. The Mayor and Council find and determine that at the hearing all assessments have been adjusted and equalized with reference to the benefits resulting from the improvements and have been apportioned among the several lots and parcels of land subject to assessment in proportion to the special benefits accrued to said lots and parcels of land respectively from such improvements; that no lot or parcel of land in said Districts has been damaged by the construction of said improvements; that the amounts of benefits specially accruing to each lot and parcel of land in said projects by reason of the construction of said paving improvements exceeds the amount assessed against each lot or parcel of land to pay the cost of said improvements. The benefits are equal and uniform and the assessments shown on the schedule hereinafter set out are according to front footage of the lots or real estate within the Districts.

3. There are hereby levied and assessed upon the several lots and parcels of land in Street Improvement Districts Nos. 2014-1 and 2014-2 special assessments to pay the cost of constructing said improvements in the amount in dollars and cents set out in the schedule below in the column headed "Special Assessments".

Said special assessments shall be a lien on the property on which they are levied from the date of the passage of this resolution and shall be certified by the City Clerk to the Treasurer of this City for collection; that the City Clerk shall also at the time provided by law cause such assessments or the portion thereof then remaining unpaid to be certified to the City Treasurer for entry upon the proper tax list; that said assessments shall be payable to and collected by the City Treasurer.
- 5. Said assessments are payable in fifteen equal installments, the first of which shall become delinquent not less than fifty (50) days from the date of adoption of the resolution, and the remaining installments shall become delinquent the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 2018, subsequent to the date of levy and thereafter, in one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen and fourteen years respectively; that each of said installments shall draw interest from the date of the passage of this resolution at the rate of three and ninety-two hundredths per centum (3.92%) per annum, until the same become delinquent, and after the same become delinquent interest at the rate specified by law for delinquent special assessments for such projects shall be paid thereon; provided all said assessments may be paid at one time on any lot or land within fifty (50) days from the date of levy without interest.

#### CITY OF BROKEN BOW ORDINANCE NO. 1178

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, CUSTER COUNTY, NEBRASKA AMENDING SECTION 30.29: MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL WAGES, REPEALING THE SECTIONS OF ALL PREVIOUS ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, CUSTER COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 30.29 of the Broken Bow Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

- (A) The Mayor shall be paid an annual wage of \$6,000.00.
- (B) The City Council shall be paid an annual wage of \$2,100.00. (Neb. RS17-108)
- Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect December 1, 2018 and after its approval and publication according to law.
