Mayor Rod Sonnichsen called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m., with the following Councilmembers present: Holcomb, Myers, Schmidt, and Miller. Absent: None.

Moved by Holcomb, seconded by Schmidt, to approve the Rural Broadband Remote Access Grant Partnership with Great Plains Communications. This Grant consists of federal dollars that are being allocated by the Nebraska Department of Economic Development (DED). This program is being offered by the state through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) Fund to allow money for fiber internet connections to rural Nebraska. Custer Economic Development Corporation (CEDC) Executive Director Andrew Ambriz stated that there is about \$40 million that has been allocated to assist communities between 1,000 and 5,000 in population in building out the fiber home access with minimum speeds of 50 megabit download and 50 megabit upload.
