Broken Bow City Council Meeting Minutes January 28, 2021

The Broken Bow City Council met in regular session on Thursday, January 28, 2021 in the Broken Bow Municipal Auditorium. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof as required by publication in the Custer County Chief on January 21, 2021. Availability of the agenda and related materials was communicated in the advanced notice to the Mayor and all members of the Council, as well as, shared with various media outlets. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Rod Sonnichsen called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., with the following Councilmembers present: Jacob Holcomb, David Schmidt, and Larry Miller. Absent: Chris Myers. Mayor Sonnichsen announced the availability of the open meetings law, followed by reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Sonnichsen read the format for submitting requests for future agenda items.

Moved by Miller, seconded by Schmidt, to approve the consent agenda for January 28, 2021. Said motion includes approval of the Minutes of the January 12, 2020 Council Meeting and Bills to Date. Roll call vote: Voting aye: Schmidt, Holcomb, and Miller. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Chief Steve Scott informed the Council on the updated standards announced by the Department of Justice for Certifying Safe Policing Practices by Law Enforcement Agencies.

Moved by Holcomb, seconded by Schmidt to open a Public Hearing at 6:20 pm regarding Ordinance 1238, No Parking Spaces. Roll Call vote: Voting aye: Holcomb, Miller, and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried. This Ordinance would designate (3) three "No Parking" spaces located on the south side of South F Street. The (1st) first (3) three parking stalls east of South 8th Avenue. Councilmember Miller expressed he would like conditions made prior to the Ordinance taking effect. Property owner Bill Butler proposed obtaining a Certificate of Occupancy prior to the Ordinance taking effect. Moved by Holcomb, seconded by Schmidt, to close a public hearing regarding Ordinance, No Parking Spaces at 6:25 pm. Roll Call vote: Voting aye: Holcomb, Miller, and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Moved by Miller, seconded by Schmidt, to approve Resolution 2021-2, Said resolution approves the call for Various Purpose Bonds, Series 2012. Roll Call vote: Voting aye: Miller, Holcomb, and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Moved by Holcomb, seconded by Schmidt, 6:37 pm to open a Public Hearing on Ordinance 1239, Ordinance issuing GO Various Purpose Refunding Bonds, Series 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$415,000. Roll Call vote: Voting aye: Holcomb, Miller, and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried. Senior Vice President Brad Slaughter with Piper Sandler & Co. informed the Council on the GO Various Purpose Refunding Bonds. Moved by Holcomb, seconded by Schmidt, 6:37 pm to close a Public Hearing on Ordinance 1239, Ordinance issuing GO Various Purpose Refunding Bonds, Series 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$415,000. Roll Call vote: Voting aye: Holcomb, Miller, and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried.

After discussing the matter, Councilmember Schmidt introduced Ordinance No. 1239 entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION VARI-OUS PURPOSE REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 2021, OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, NEBRASKA, IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$415,000) TO REFUND CERTAIN OUTSTANDING BONDS OF THE CITY; PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF SAID BONDS; PROVIDING FOR A SINKING FUND AND FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES TO PAY SAID BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF THE BONDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE DELIVERY OF THE BONDS TO THE PURCHASER; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF THE BOND PROCEEDS AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET" FORM,"and moved that the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. Moved by Holcomb, seconded by Schmidt, 6:40 pm to open a Public Hearing on Ordinance 1240, Ordinance issuing GO Various Purpose Refunding Bonds, Series 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$1,880,000. Roll Call vote: Voting aye: Holcomb, Miller, and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried. Senior Vice President Brad Slaughter with Piper Sandler & Co. informed the Council on the GO Various Purpose Refunding Bonds. Moved by Holcomb, Seconded by Miller, 6:40 pm to close a Public Hearing on Ordinance 1240, Ordinance issuing GO Various Purpose Refunding Bonds, Series 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$1,880,000. Roll Call vote: Voting aye: Holcomb, Miller, and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried.

After discussing the matter, Councilmember Miller introduced Ordinance No. 1240 entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 2021, OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, NEBRASKA, IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,880,000) TO REFUND CERTAIN OUTSTANDING

BONDS OF THE CITY; PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF SAID BONDS; PROVIDING FOR A SINKING FUND AND FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES TO PAY SAID BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF THE BONDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE DELIVERY OF THE BONDS TO THE PURCHASER; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF THE BOND PROCEEDS AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM."and moved that the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. CITY OF BROKEN BOW

ORDINANCE NO.1242

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, CUSTER COUNTY, NEBRASKA AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ESTABLISHING A QUORUM AT CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS; TO HARMONIZE WITH STATE LAW; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS; AND PRIVIDING A TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The city's Code of Ordinance is revised to read as follows regarding City Council meetings:

COUNCIL MEETINGS; WHEN; QUORUM; VOTES.

- (A) Regular meetings of the City Council shall be held at such times as the Council may provide be ordinance. A majority of all the members elected to the Council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business, but a fewer number may adjourn from time to time and compel the attendance of absent members. When the City Council consists of 4 members as established by ordinance or home rule charter, the Mayor shall be deemed a member of the City Council for purposes of establishing a quorum when the Mayor's presence is necessary to establish the quorum. Unless a greater vote is required by law, an affirmative vote of ½ of the elected members shall be required for the transaction of any business. (Neb. RS 17-105)
- (B) (1) The mayor or any 3 Councilmembers shall have the power to call special meetings of the City Council, the object of which shall be submitted to the Council in writing; and the call and object, as well as the disposition thereof, shall be entered upon the journal by the City Clerk.
- (2) On filing the call for a special meeting, the City Clerk shall notify the Mayor and Councilmembers of the special meeting, stating the time and purpose.
- (C) Unless otherwise provided by the Council, on the request of any 2 members, whether a quorum is present or not, all absent members shall be sent for and compelled to attend.
- (D) At the hour appointed for a meeting, the City Clerk shall proceed to call roll of members and announce whether a quorum is present. If a quorum is present, the Council shall be called to order by the Mayor, if present, or if absent, by the President of the Council.
- Section 2. Any other ordinance or code section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and conflict with its provisions is repealed.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting as required by law.
