RESOLUTION 2021-15

RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1601.02 provides that the Governing Body of the City of Broken Bow passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request; NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the City of Broken Bow, resolves that:

- 1. The 2020-2021 property tax request be set at:
 - a. General Fund \$1,080,903.00 b. Bond Fund \$275,074.00 Total \$1,355,977.00
- 2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 1%.
- 3. The City of Broken Bow proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$.627243 per \$100 of assessed value.
- 4. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of City of Broken Bow will be more than last year's by 1%.
- 5. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 13, 2021.
