The Clerk is directed to cause said notice to be mailed to owners of property subject to assessment as provided by statute.

The special engineer is directed to prepare and file in the office of the Clerk prior to the first publication of the Notice of the said hearing on special assessments a map of the property benefited by the improvements constructed in connection with the 2018 South 19th Avenue and South G Street Paving Improvements and a tentative schedule of the assessments, which shall be open to the public.
