RESOLUTION 2025-04

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATORS TO PURSUE A \$250,000 HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT TO CONDUCT A FLOODPLAIN SCOPING PROJECT WITH A FINANCIAL COMMITMENT OF 25% OR \$62,500 FROM THE CITY TOWARDS THIS FUTURE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Broken Bow desires to pursue a Hazard Mitigation Grant in the amount of \$250,000 to conduct a floodplain scoping project to enhance community safety and resilience against flooding; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Broken Bow acknowledges a financial commitment of 25% of the project cost, equivalent to \$62,500, as a local match for said grant; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Broken Bow, Nebraska approves and authorizes the City Floodplain Administrators to pursue a \$250,000 Hazard Mitigation Grant for the floodplain scoping project, committing \$62,500 from the City as the local match for this future project.

RESOLUTION 2025-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REALLOCATION OF BUDGETED FUNDS FROM THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS LINE ITEM TO FUND REPAIRS TO THE BROKEN BOW PUBLIC LIBRARY ROOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Broken Bow, Nebraska, is a *City of the Second Class* duly organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statute § 13-504, the City Council of Broken Bow has the authority to adopt an annual budget and make appropriations for the operation, maintenance, and improvement of municipal facilities; and

WHEREAS, the roof of the Broken Bow Public Library, a municipal facility, has been identified as <u>requiring immediate repair</u> to ensure the safety of the public and the preservation of public property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that sufficient funds are available within the current fiscal year budget under the Municipal Building Improvements line item, General Ledger (GL) Account Number 02-3411.00, to fund the priority improvements for the Municipal Building and the Library roof repairs; and

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute § 13-510 permits the City Council to transfer or reallocate budgeted funds within the same fund when necessary to meet unforeseen needs, provided such action complies with the Nebraska Budget Act (§§ 13-501 to 13-513); and


WHEREAS, the estimated cost to repair the Broken Bow Public Library roof is not expected to exceed \$40,000, and the City Council finds it prudent and necessary to reallocate funds from GL Account Number 02-3411.00 to cover this expense; and

WHEREAS, this reallocation will <u>not exceed the total budgeted appropriations</u> for the current fiscal year and complies with all applicable statutory requirements, including public notice and hearing provisions as required under Nebraska


Revised Statute § 13-506, if applicable.




